

RESOLUTION NO.1098

WHEREAS, the Colby Recreation Commission has adopted a resolution declaring it necessary to increase the annual property tax levy for the use of such Commission to operate a public recreation system and has requested the City to authorize a maximum mill levy of not to exceed 3.00 mills; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1927 authorize the City to provide for a tax levy and an increase in tax levy, subject to a petition of the voters for a referendum thereon;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the City of Colby that the Colby Recreation Commission be authorized to levy a tax in the year 2017 and thereafter not to exceed 3.00 mills, plus any additional levy necessary to offset deductions, limitations, or decreases due to the effects of the Neighborhood Revitalization Program or other tax incentive reductions or limitations now in effect for hereafter implemented, subject to such petition and referendum requirement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper and that an amount no exceeding said maximum mill levy may be levied by the Recreation Commission unless a petition requesting an election upon the proposition, signed by at least five percent of the qualified voters of the City shall be filed with the county election officer within 30 days following the date of the last publication of this resolution.
