

ORDINANCE NO. 1573

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS; ADOPTING AND INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2016; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES; REPEALING CHAPTER XIV, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 14-101, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS, 2007 EDITION; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1556.

WHEREAS, the City of Colby, Kansas, as authorized under K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012, including any amendments thereon, K.S.A. 12-3301 and 12-3302, to adopt and incorporate by reference the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, Edition of 2016, as prepared and published by the League of Kansas Municipalities; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Colby, Kansas, finds it necessary and to the best interest of the City to adopt and incorporate by reference the said Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, Edition of 2016, as above described.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Code of the City of Colby, Kansas which is a codification of the general ordinances of the City of Colby was adopted, incorporated by reference, and approved by the City Council on June 19, 2007.

SECTION 2. Chapter XIV. Traffic – Article 1. Standard Traffic Ordinance – Section 14-101. Incorporating Standard Traffic Ordinance of the Municipal Code of the City of Colby, Kansas, of the Municipal Code of the City of Colby, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Chapter XIV. Traffic – Article 1. Standard Traffic Ordinance – Section 14-101. Incorporating Standard Traffic Ordinance of the Municipal Code of the City of Colby, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

14-101. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Colby, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2016 prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1573," and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the City charged with enforcement of the Ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 1556 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication in the official City newspaper as provided by law.
