

RESOLUTION NO. 1067

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SECURITY PLAN FOR THE COLBY COMMUNITY BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the City of Colby is a municipal corporation with authority under Kansas law to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions regulating conduct within the City of Colby, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the Kansas Legislature, in Senate Substitute for House Bill No. 2052, enacted certain legislation amending the Personal and Family Protection Act which authorizes carrying concealed handguns by persons licensed to do so in certain public buildings; and

WHEREAS, provisions of the legislation authorize the governing body of state or municipal buildings to exempt buildings from the provisions of the act for a period of four years only by adopting a resolution in conformance with the Act including the following statement: "a security plan has been developed for the building being exempted which supplies adequate security to the occupants of the building and merits the prohibition of the carrying of a concealed handgun as authorized by the Personal and Family Protection Act."; and

WHEREAS, the Colby Community Building is a multi-purpose facility used by many organizations and other governmental entities, including Unified School District No. 315 and Colby Community College, located at 285 East 5th Street, Colby, Kansas more particularly described as: All of Lots One (1), Four (4), Five (5), Eight (8), Nine (9), "B" (B), Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), and Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17), and Twenty (20), all in Block Eleven (11) in the Original Town of Colby, Thomas County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Colby deems it to be in the best interest of all users of the Colby Community Building that guns, other firearms and weapons only be permitted in the Colby Community Building when possessed by Law Enforcement officers and that concealed handguns should not be permitted in the Colby Community Building.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT:

SECTION 1. The security plan prepared for the Colby Community Building be and the same is hereby adopted.

SECTION 2. The security plan for the Colby Community Building shall not be subject to disclosure under the Kansas Open Records Act, all as specifically authorized by Senate Substitute for House Bill No. 2052.

SECTION 3. The period of this exemption shall be effective immediately and continue until changed by the City of Colby, but not longer than four years ending January 1, 2018.

SECTION 4. A copy of the security plan for the Colby Community Building shall be maintained on file at the office of the Colby City Manager. The security plan shall be made available, upon request, to the Kansas Attorney General, the Thomas County Sheriff's Department and the Colby Police Department. The plan shall not be subject to further disclosure and shall not be considered a public record.

SECTION 5. Tyson McGreer, City Manager, shall send a copy of this Resolution to the Kansas Attorney General, Thomas County Sheriff's Department and the Colby Police Department.
